The NCUA has warned numerous times 1 about "phishing" scams in which crooks send e-mails claiming to be from legitimate financial institutions, companies, or government agencies asking consumers to "verify" or "re-submit" confidential information such as bank account and credit card numbers, Social Security Numbers, passwords, and personal identification numbers. A variant on that approach using telephone systems, vishing, is increasingly being used to obtain this information from unwary consumers.

Please read the included document, as it contains important training and informational material regarding the risks of fraud, "phishing", "vishing", and ways to protect your member's and your Credit Union's assets.
