AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mr. MCCAIN

Viz:

- 1 At the end of subtitle H of title X, add the following:
- 2 **SEC. 1088. CYBERSECURITY COLLABORATION BETWEEN**
- 3 **THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE AND THE DE-**
- 4 **PARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY.**
- 5 (a) INTERDEPARTMENTAL COLLABORATION.—
- 6 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Defense
- 7 and the Secretary of Homeland Security shall pro-
- 8 vide personnel, equipment, and facilities in order to
- 9 increase interdepartmental collaboration with respect
- 10 to—

1 (A) strategic planning for the cybersecurity  
2 of the United States;

3 (B) mutual support for cybersecurity capa-  
4 bilities development; and

5 (C) synchronization of current operational  
6 cybersecurity mission activities.

7 (2) EFFICIENCIES.—The collaboration provided  
8 for under paragraph (1) shall be designed—

9 (A) to improve the efficiency and effective-  
10 ness of requirements formulation and requests  
11 for products, services, and technical assistance  
12 for, and coordination and performance assess-  
13 ment of, cybersecurity missions executed across  
14 a variety of Department of Defense and De-  
15 partment of Homeland Security elements; and

16 (B) to leverage the expertise of each indi-  
17 vidual Department and to avoid duplicating,  
18 replicating, or aggregating unnecessarily the di-  
19 verse line organizations across technology devel-  
20 opments, operations, and customer support that  
21 collectively execute the cybersecurity mission of  
22 each Department.

23 (b) RESPONSIBILITIES.—

24 (1) DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY.—

25 The Secretary of Homeland Security shall identify

1       and assign, in coordination with the Department of  
2       Defense, a Director of Cybersecurity Coordination  
3       within the Department of Homeland Security to un-  
4       dertake collaborative activities with the Department  
5       of Defense.

6               (2) DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE.—The Sec-  
7       retary of Defense shall identify and assign, in co-  
8       ordination with the Department of Homeland Secu-  
9       rity, one or more officials within the Department of  
10      Defense to coordinate, oversee, and execute collabo-  
11      rative activities and the provision of cybersecurity  
12      support to the Department of Homeland Security.
